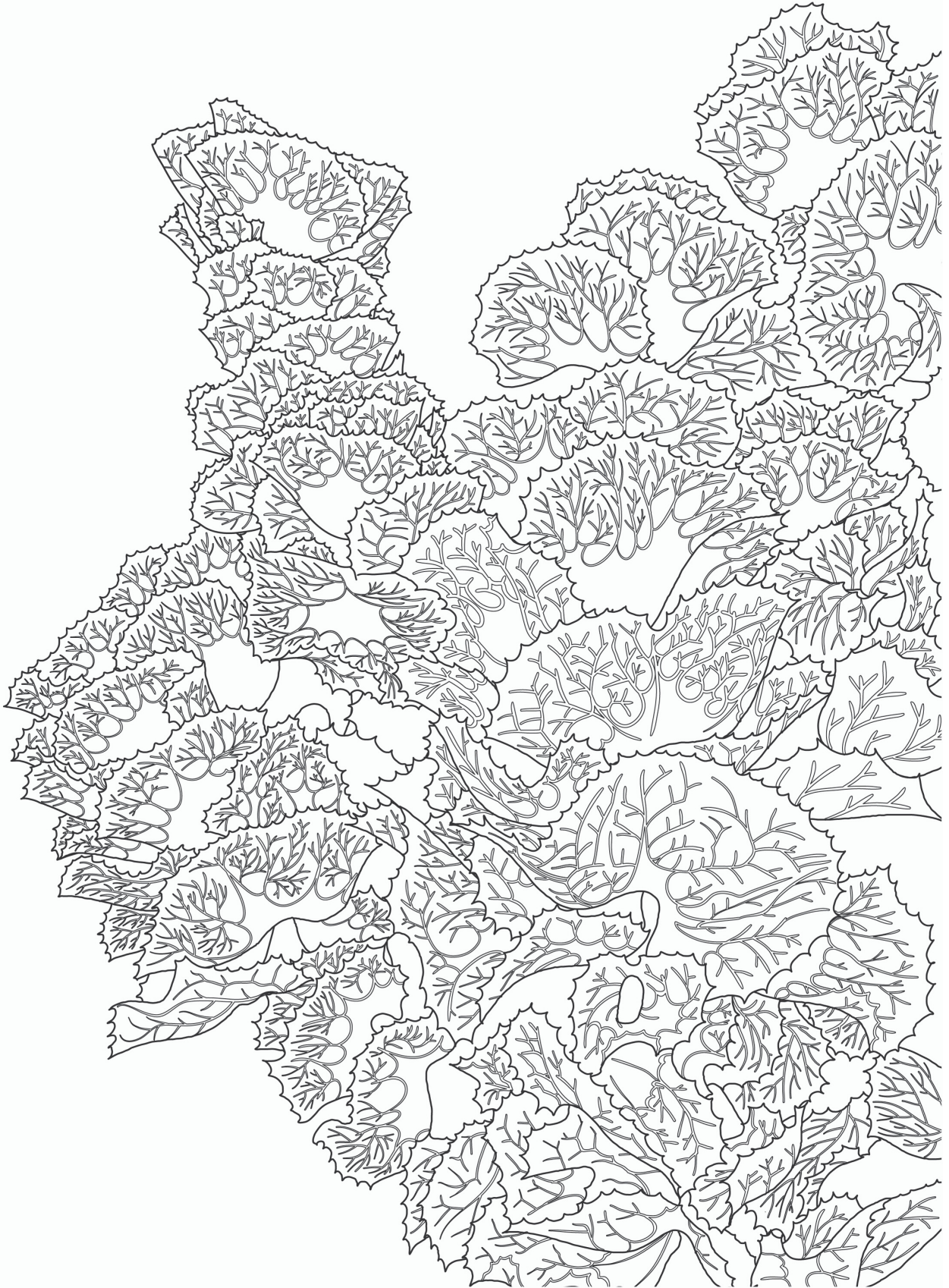

SOUTHERN WESTERN AUSTRALIA

This unusual endemic plant can grow to over 2.5 metres with stiff and slightly concave leaves variegated in many shades of cream, yellow, orange, red, brown and green - making it very attractive.

While the **Royal Hakea** is not threatened, it is rare as it only grows throughout parts of the Fitzgerald River National Park and Fitzgerald Biosphere.

Its small and unremarkable flower is cream and furry sprouting from the centre of the leaf.
